- Ed Klotzbier, Vice Chancellor of External Relations
  - President of the UC Merced Foundation
  - External Relations provides support to share our story broadly and to our campus
    - Inspired donation from businesses and local leaders
    - Money Magazine named UC Merced "One of America's Best Colleges"
    - Times Higher Education: lauded among young universities
  - Pre-med student cohort will start in August 2023
  - New Majors:
    - Chemical Engineering
    - Data Science and Analytics
    - Data Science and Computing
    - Environmental Humanities
  - Want more funding for more research labs, residence halls, athletic amenities, indoor event spaces, and student success programs
  - UC Merced Foundation
    - The foundation was created in 2000, prior to the school's opening, to raise funds and administer private philanthropic support to assist the university's teaching, research, and public service mission
    - Monya Lane and Robert Bryant Presidential Chair in Excellence in Engineering awarded to Dr. Ashlie Martini
    - The Foundation Board of Trustees is composed of business and community leaders from across the state and throughout the nation. They work closely with the chancellor and the campus administration to identify key priorities and opportunities for engagement in order to support the university's efforts.

  - Retired from Lawrence Livermore Lab
  - Lawrence Labs are managed by University of California

- Supported efforts for the UC Merced Project 2020 led by Chancellor Leland
- Trustees Role: assist in general financial support as determined by Chancellor of UC Merced
- Chair Role: Coordinate and align the work that we do as a board, to be most effective in supporting the strategic plan of the university and specifically now to support the Boldly Forward campaign
  - Executive committee met in June and changed working groups to be clearly aligned with the strategic pillars which are leading through discovery, cultivating healthy societies, and empowering student
- Discussed the Evolution of the Board of Trustees from 2000 to present
- Q&A Session:
  - How, how do you see the role of alumni and how can they affect the role of the Foundation?
    - Ed: Continue speaking on panels and mentoring of students, endow scholarships, advocate for internship/job opportunities at your companies, and identify alumni groups in your organizations
      - Example: Gallo Winery speak highly of their alumni group
  - What is the pathway for an alum to join the Board of Trustees?
    - Ed: Traditionally have not had alumni participate at the board level given the nature of its philanthropic mission. For many other UCs, more than half of their foundation members are alumni of that respective institution. What was instituted several years ago was a one-year term for an alum to participate at the foundation.
    - Former UCMAA Board member, Dr. Trevor Albertson '09, is the first alum to serve in the capacity of a trustee
    - Linda Barreto '08, has been selected as the incoming alumni representative for the Board of Trustees.
    - Monya: encourage alumni to participate in working groups
  - What do you envision with Board 4.0?
    - Monya: As a chair of the foundation board, I am invited to a UC-wide meeting with chairs across the UCs to strategize together about the needs for UC
      - UC Merced would have a UC Advocacy day in Sacramento for UC-wide efforts as as more opportunities to encourage the state legislator to support UC Merced
  - How to get opportunities to meet with trustees?
    - Ed: We can work with JaeJae to find opportunities
